

GENERAL INFORMATION

1. Each rider must sign a waiver of liability at registration.
2. The used of protective headgear is required in all hunt seat & over fences classes and for riders under 18 years of age, regardless of discipline. Riders will not be counted off for the use of a helmet. **ERC encourages the use of protective headgear for all riders.**
3. Horses that kick must be marked with a red tail ribbon. If a horse not wearing a red tail ribbons kicks, the horse may be disqualified from all classes and no money will be refunded.
4. Class changes must be made at least two classes ahead of the class you want to add or drop.
5. **THERE WILL BE A TWO MINUTE GATE CALL**
6. There will be no schooling over fences in the ring
7. Timed events start and stop in the ring.
8. Trail Class: Pattern posted at show prior to class. Disqualification on an obstacle occurs from going off course as in backing, turning, inappropriate gait, or stopping where it is not part of the pattern, excessive use of reins, kicking, crops, and/or spurs, or two refusals. Any of these requires the rider and horse to move on to the next obstacle.
9. Breed Classes: Gaited classes are open to all gaited breeds, flat shod only. No action devices, soreing, or altering of natural gait will be tolerated. Color Class is open to horses with paint, overo, tobiano or unique markings.
10. Riders for **Leadline** may not enter any other classes except **Costume or Therapeutic**.
11. Any act of discourtesy toward the judge or show officials will result in immediate removal from the show grounds.
12. Only riders or owners of the horse involved may make protests. Protest must be made in a courteous manner to the Judge, whose has the final call on the protest.

13. Lamé or sore horse will not be allowed in any class under any circumstances.
14. Excessive use of whips or spurs will not be tolerated
15. Appropriate behavior and respect must be shown to all horses always.
16. The Show Judge will have FINAL say on class placing
17. **Dogs and Alcoholic Beverages Are Not Permitted on Show Grounds.**

RULES AND REGULATIONS

W: Walk **T: Trot** **C: Canter**
G: Gaited **J: Jog** **L: Lope**

CLASSES: USEF rules apply. **No Martingales in flat classes.** Three entries constitute a class. Classes with less than three entries will be awarded ribbons only. ERC is not liable for any injury or death of a participant in equine activities resulting exclusively from the inherent risks of equine activities- Chapter 99E of the North Carolina General Statute.

AGE LIMIT CLASSES: The age of the horse and riders are based on their age as of January 1st of the current year.

RESPONSIBILITY: For personal safety of person, horses, vehicle responsibility and belongings must be accepted by individuals entering the show grounds and by participating riders. Neither the Etowah Riding Club, nor the owner of the show grounds, club officers, or club members will accept responsibility for any accidents that may occur to any person, animal, property, or vehicles on the grounds. Under North Carolina Law, and Equine Activity Sponsor or Equine Professional Statutes.
